Legislative Alert Update

H. Res. 672

February 6, 2020 Update

As of today, H. Res. 672 has attracted the support of support 36 House members, 35 of whom are the co-sponsors and 1 being the original sponsor (see page 6 for state-by-state PAC Divisions and Texas, for current details) in this, the 2nd Session of the 116th United States Congress. Whereas we are free to decide what objectives, particularly those that benefit Poland, to pursue by legislative action on Capitol Hill, unless H. Res. 672 is passed by both the House of Representatives and the Senate by December 31, 2020, it will be considered dead, and will have to attract new House and Senate sponsors and co-sponsors in a process from the beginning all over again for the forthcoming 117th United States Congress that begins on January 3, 2021.

While we may be unable to prevent Vladimir Putin from defaming Poland, settle once and for all the matter of WWII – Communist era property compensation claims, and foster Poland’s integral role in the European Union, for example, we have every opportunity to work for the successful passage of the “Three Seas Initiative,” simply because Poland is involved in it along with Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia. I may be mistaken, however, but speculatively speaking, I doubt that there are many Austrian Americans, Bulgarian Americans, Croatian Americans, etc., involved in this telephone lobbying process. Look at the numbers, the 35 House co-sponsors supporting H. Res. 672, represent **8% of the 435 members of the full House.**

Of the 35 co-sponsors, 30 (6.9%**) come from states with Polish American Congress state Divisions, along with Texas. The remaining 5 (**1.1%**) co-sponsors come from Washington with 2, and Mississippi, North Carolina and Tennessee, with 1 each.**

As of the moment, Poland’s fellow beneficiaries of H. Res. 672 likely benefit by the fact that the Polish American Congress propels this particular initiative, as usual. Nevertheless, Polish Americans are duty-bound

to work for the passage of the “Threes Seas Initiative” legislation in the 116th Congress, despite the odds against passage during the remaining calendar months of 2020.

All 19 States in which we have Divisions of the Polish American Congress (AZ, CA, CT, DE, FL, IL, IN, MA, MD, MI, MO, NH, NJ, NY, OH, PA, RI, VA an WI) and in TX where we are developing a cadre of individual members are asked to participate from this point on in lobbying their members of the House of Representatives, 116th United States Congress, for signing on as co-sponsors of: **H. Res. 672 (“Expressing support of the Three Seas Initiative in its efforts to increase energy independence and infrastructure connectivity thereby strengthening the United States and European national security.”)**

It is indeed a rare moment in today’s fractured United States Congress when a Democrat, Marcy Kaptur (D-OH) and a Republican, Adam Kinzinger (R-IL), refuse to accede to the contrary designs of Russia’s Vladimir Putin by co-sponsoring this legislation – known generally as the “Three Seas Initiative” -- to provide energy security for the East Central European nations either bordering, or within the zone of, the Baltic, Black and Adriatic Seas,

POLAND included, as described by the press release issued by Kaptur and Kinzinger on October 31, 2019:

Washington, D.C. — Today, Representatives Marcy Kaptur (D-OH) and Adam Kinzinger (R-IL) introduced a bipartisan resolution in support of the **Three Seas Initiative (3SI)**, a strategic partnership of twelve Central and Eastern European nations with the shared goal to foster energy autonomy and resilience through collective financing of new infrastructure projects, increasing connectivity between the Adriatic, Baltic, and Black Seas, and reducing their reliance on Russia for their energy needs.

Three Seas Initiative Membership includes: **Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, and Slovenia.**

“For years, Russia has undermined security in Europe by coercing European nations into reliance on Russia for their energy needs, including through the Nord Stream II and Turk Stream pipelines,” said **Rep. Kaptur**. “Thankfully, twelve of our close allies in Central and Eastern Europe have banded together to increase their energy autonomy through collective financing of energy infrastructure projects: The Three Sea’s Initiative. This resolution makes clear America’s strong support for the Initiative and it encourages the member nations to consider financing of clean energy projects as the world addresses dire climate change crises. Now that Danish authorities have approved the Nord Stream II pipeline, we must now act swiftly to boost the energy security of our European allies by passing this critical legislation as well as sanctioning the pipeline. I wish to thank my colleague, Representative Adam Kinzinger for his critical leadership, and efforts to strengthen the transatlantic relationship through this bill.”

“Russia has long used energy as a weapon to coerce and manipulate our European allies,” said **Congressman Kinzinger**. “As American energy production continues to rise, we have an opportunity to support our allies in Central and Eastern Europe with an alternative. The Three Seas Initiative will bolster energy independence and infrastructure security in the region, and further show U.S. support in the face of increased Russian and Chinese influence over these countries. I’m proud to introduce this resolution with my colleague, Representative Marcy Kaptur, and applaud her commitment to helping our allies with clean energy projects as we push back on the power grabs by Putin.”

I ask each Division, along with Texas, to engage, as a point of honor, in the on-going telephone lobbying campaign to the place of business of their respective

Congressmen/women (i.e., on Capitol Hill in Washington, DC).

The substance of the call should be as follows:

Hello,

My name is _____, an informed American of Polish descent who resides at _____, thus making me a voting constituent of **Representative** _____. I am asking him / her to become a co-sponsor of House Resolution 672 that is generally known as the “Three Seas Initiative” which seeks to strengthen energy security, among other matters, from Russian dominance, control and threat over the twelve European Union nations bordering, or included in the region of, the Baltic, Adriatic and Black Seas, now constituting the basis of the Three Seas Initiative: they are Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, **Poland**, Romania, Slovakia, and Slovenia, none of which want to revert to the Cold War era of Soviet Russian-imposed political, military, economic and social control of what had been the sad reality of East Central Europe from 1945 to 1989.

Today, Putin’s Russian Federation not only hopes to see this House Resolution 672 legislation fail, but likely will also exercise every subversive activity on the soil of the United States via social media and cyber-warfare to guarantee its failure.

I hope that Representative _____ understands this ever-looming Russian threat to the energy security of the Three Seas Initiative nations, and decides to becoming a co-sponsor of House Resolution 672. I and other Polish Americans in our state will remember his/her support when we vote.
